As articulated in the Corporate Safety Policy Statement on Health, Safety and the Environment, Trican and its subsidiaries support the Industry Guiding Principles of Worker Safety, which states:

As Corporate members of the Petroleum Industry, we have a responsibility to protect the environment, members of society and all workers engaged in our activities from personal injury and health hazards.

To meet our responsibility, we will operate under the following guiding principles:

RESPONSIBILITY

Trican and its subsidiaries, when acting as the prime contractor, are responsible for the coordination and general supervision of all activities at the work site, including activities carried out by contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers. While all parties have a responsibility to promote worker safety, the Corporation recognizes its leadership role in promoting workers' health and safety on the basis that it has the greatest influence over establishing a safe work site. It is the responsibility of employees and employers to refuse to perform unsafe work.

PRIORITY

All activities will be conducted on the basis that the safety of all personnel is of vital importance, whether or not those individuals are employed by the Corporation, a contractor, a subcontractor, or a supplier.

RECOGNITION

The process of selecting contractors, subcontractors and suppliers, and the administration of contracts, will include the recognition and support of good safety policies and performance.

IMPROVEMENT

Trican and its subsidiaries, in cooperation with others within the industry, will promote methods and practices that have the potential for improving safety performance.
